The walk that starts from the San Vincenzo pier will take you right into the middle of the sea, through an evocative route that is beautiful in every season. FALCON TIP PLUMMET

PIAZZA BOVIO PLUMMET



STREE OBJAE CAVALRY DUMMET

ASCACNI TERRACE LIVORNO

A super instagrammable classic. The Terrace, named after the composer Mascagni, fascinates with its simplicity and elegance: a chessboard and a small balustrade, then the sea as far as the eye can see. A magical place, especially at sunset.

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A breathtaking view of the sea and an enchanting location in every season of the year: the Castello del Boccale in Antignano, Livorno, is a place that deserves to be photographed!
